### **Reboletti: Governor's Speech was Grandstanding**

Springfield, IL ... Governor Quinn's State of the State address lacked details on how to fix the Illinois budget and boost the state's economy, said State Representative Dennis Reboletti (R-Elmhurst).

"The Governor gave absolutely no details on how he plans to fix the state's financial crisis and boost the state's economy, instead he used the state of the state platform as a political infomercial," said Reboletti. "While we desperately need to look to the future and ways to rebuild the state, it seems Quinn is more focused on his primary campaign."

The Governor also failed to mention his intention to raise taxes, which he plans to promote after the February 2 primary.

"Despite our high unemployment rate the Governor continues to push for a 50-percent increase in the state's income tax on working families and employers. I will continue to fight against all tax increases. We need to focus on growing our economy instead of the tax rate," said Reboletti.

The Democrats financial mismanagement has resulted in more than \$6 billion of unpaid bills to school districts, universities, and healthcare providers, said Reboletti.

"Last year, the Governor promised to cut the state budget but instead he 'strategically' borrowed billions of dollars to pay the state's bills. This credit card mentality has brought our deficit to more than \$12 billion and climbing. This needs to stop," he said.
