Reboletti Named Republican Spokesperson to Criminal Law, Juvenile Justice Reform Committees

Addison, IL ... State Representative Dennis Reboletti (R-Elmhurst) was recently appointed to serve as spokesperson to the coveted House Judiciary II – Criminal Law Committee and Juvenile Justice Reform Committee by House Republican Leader Tom Cross.
