### **Reboletti Filed Bill Urging Burris to Resign** *Democrats Refuse Vote on Resolution*

Springfield, IL ... This week State Representative Dennis Reboletti (R-Elmhurst) filed House Resolution 92 calling for the resignation of U.S. Senator Roland Burris. After a request to discharge the resolution from the Rules Committee on Thursday, the House Democrats refused to allow a vote on the resolution.

“Senator Burris has shown us that he is not capable of adequately serving the citizens of Illinois. He dodged questions and lied to the House Impeachment Committee about his appointment to the seat and then filed an affidavit weeks later that contained several discrepancies. His story has consistently changed day to day. We need a leader who seeks elected office to serve people, not to enhance his political clout and resume,” said Reboletti. “The Democrats refusal to vote on the resolution shows their lack of urgency on this very serious issue. Once again, the House Democrats are denying the citizens of Illinois the right to have their voices heard.”

During the House Impeachment Committee hearing, Burris failed to disclose information that while seeking the appointment for the Senate seat, he tried to raise money for the former governor.

Upon the resignation of Burris, Reboletti also continues to push for a special election to fill the U.S. Senate seat vacated by President Barack Obama.

“When there is a vacancy in the House, a special election is held to give voters the opportunity to choose their next voice in Congress. A special election should have been held for the U.S. Senate seat as well. Unfortunately, this continuing saga proves that voters deserve a chance to elect someone who will listen to their needs and vote for them in Washington DC,” said Reboletti.
