Reboletti Sponsors Disabled Veterans Property Tax Relief Legislation

Addison, IL ... As property assessments continue to rise, State Representative Dennis Reboletti (R-Elmhurst) recently sponsored legislation to provide new property tax benefits for disabled veterans.

“Illinois is home to thousands of disabled veterans who selflessly put their lives in danger to defend our country and protect our freedoms. It’s imperative that we ensure our veterans are taken care of. House Bill 273 provides property tax relief to disabled veterans and their families as assessments continue to rise,” said Reboletti.

House Bill 273 requires the county clerk to abate a percentage of the property taxes levied on each parcel of property owned and used exclusively as a home by a disabled veteran. The abatement also used by the spouse or unmarried surviving spouse of the disabled veteran. The percentage of taxes to be abated is equal to the percentage of disability of the veteran.

“Last year we made great strides in helping the veteran community and their families through legislation providing homebuyer assistance and caring for veterans suffering from Traumatic Brain Injury or Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, however there is still more work to be done. House Bill 273 is a step in the right direction,” said Reboletti who has been in touch with area disabled veterans about the property tax abatement issue.
