Reboletti: House Passes Pension Modernization to General Assembly and Judge's Pension System

Springfield ... State Representative Dennis Reboletti (R-Elmhurst) said he was pleased by the unanimous House passage of legislation which would reform the pension system for judges and members of the General Assembly.

Reboletti noted that House Bill 6368, which he cosponsored, would raise the age of eligibility, eliminate annual cost of living adjustments and cap benefits for all judges and General Assembly members.

“With the state’s current budget deficit, it was common sense to start first with reforming the pension system for ourselves and other public officials,” said Rep. Reboletti.

Reboletti added that he along with his colleagues previously sent a letter to the Governor which outlined dozens of ideas to control spending, create private sector jobs and reform Medicaid.

“My hope is that the Governor will continue to review our fiscal reforms,” said Rep. Reboletti. “As the session moves forward, we hope to find a solution to the state’s budget problems without raising taxes on the working class families of this state.”
