### **Reboletti Veterans Property Tax Exemption Bill Passes General Assembly**

Springfield, IL ... Legislation, sponsored by State Representative Dennis Reboletti (R-Elmhurst), to expand property tax exemptions for veterans recently passed the General Assembly.

“The young men and women who fight for our freedom deserve their share of the American dream of home ownership. The tax exemption is one small way Illinois can show appreciation for risking their lives for our freedom,” said Reboletti, who serves on the Veterans Affairs Committee.

Senate Bill 2350 allows veterans who purchase a new home when they return from an armed conflict to receive the \$5,000 Returning Veterans’ Homestead Exemption for that year’s assessment, payable in the following tax year.

Currently veterans must already own their home in order to receive a \$5,000 Returning Veterans’ Homestead Exemption when they return from active duty in an armed conflict involving the armed forces of the United States.

The legislation unanimously passed the House on April 29 and the Senate on March 9. The bill will now be sent to the Governor.
